- **Internships**

Met students acquire internships, where they gain real world experience and educationally enriching contacts.

The Met is a small public charter high school in Sacramento, California. Each Met student has an individualized curriculum which includes academic learning at internships in the community. Our school model is inspired by a national network of 54 similar schools, all founded by *The Big Picture Company*.
